# Here Comes the Likud Election! By Moshe Feiglin- Candidate for Likud Chair

This coming week, the Likud Central Committee will schedule the Likud primaries - likely in the next two or three months. For Manhigut Yehudit, primaries are the golden opportunity to achieve the leadership position in

the Likud and - no less important - to get our message of belief-based leadership into every home in Israel. The intensive media coverage that the primaries afford is unparalleled in any other public relations campaign that we could initiate.

The State of Israel cannot continue to exist for much longer without belief-based leadership. That is why losing is not an option. We must be sure that we are ready for the primaries. We need to enlist all of the healthy, belief-based forces that the Jewish People can muster - both volunteers and contributors. We must make sure that every person who has signed up for the Likud through Manhigut Yehudit actually does go to vote - even if he is in the middle of his summer vacation on the Kinneret! We must go house to house and reach all the Likud members - just like we did successfully before the Likud's Disengagement referendum - and explain that authentic Jewish leadership can save Israel. We need contributions to allow us to build an effective campaign. No less important, we have to honestly desire to lead Israel to its Jewish destiny. We must pray with all our hearts that this time, people who genuinely wish to perfect the world in the Kingdom of the Almighty will be given the chance to lead.

This is no ordinary electoral race. Israel's future - the future of each and every Jew in the world - is at stake. And each and every one of us can make a difference.

## Who's the REAL Likudnik?

People often ask us why we are in the Likud party. Well, besides the fact that the Likud is the only party which comprises a true cross-section of Israeli society, and that it's the only "nationalist" party which produces Prime Ministers, the official Likud Charter states the following as one of it's main objectives:

#### "Preserving the right of the Jewish Nation to the Land of Israel as an eternal, inalienable right; perseverance in the settlement and development of all parts of the Land of Israel; implementation of the State's sovereignty on them."

When we compare Moshe Feiglin (who is in lock-step with the Likud Charter's main objective) to his challengers for the Likud Chairmanship - former PM Benjamin "Bibi" Netanyahu & former Foreign Minister Silvan Shalom - we see that both of the opponents are sorely lacking in faithfulness to the Likud's objective as evidenced by the fact that both support creating an Arab state inside the Biblical heartland of Israel - Judea & Samaria - and both supported Ariel Sharon's Expulsion of 10,000 Jews from Gaza (as opposed to Moshe on both points).

As Prime Minister, Bibi said he'd end the Oslo Accords (but he didn't), he refused to stand up for Jonathan Pollard, he pulled the IDF out of Hebron (which resulted in Jewish blood being spilled), and he let Arafat get away scot-free with murdering 16 Jewish soldiers with guns provided him by Rabin. He was also negotiating the giveaway of the Golan Heights to Syria. After his term as PM ended, he supported Sharon's Expulsion from Gaza, and now he supports strengthening Abu Mazen's Fatah Party. Bibi claims that Fatah (the controlling group in the PLO) are the "moderate palestinians" and the best hope for creating an Arab state in Judea & Samaria (the "West Bank")

#### But Who are Abu Mazen & Fatah?

Even if one disregards Bibi's blatant contravention of the Likud Charter in supporting the creation of another terror state in Israel, shouldn't we take a look at Mahmoud Abbas (aka "Abu Mazen") and his Fatah group? His Fatah has committed more terror acts than all the other terrorist groups combined (including Hamas) since the Oslo Accords were signed, so how can anyone say they are "moderate"?

Abu Mazen is on record as stating that he'll never give up the so-called "palestinian right of return" which would destroy Israel through demographics, and that he'll never disarm any terror groups. He is also a co-author of the PLO's 1974 "Phases" Plan for destroying Israel by taking what they can through negotiations prior to launching an all-out military assault to take the rest of Israel. It looks to anyone with their eyes open that he's following his own plan. And where did

that plan come from? Fatah was created by Hajj Amin al Hus-

seini

(Arafat's mentor), top architect of Hitler's German Nazi Final Solution. Just look at al Husseini with Hitler and look at how Abu Mazen salutes and speaks and you'll clearly see that these *moderates* are just Nazis dressed up with platitudes for their western audience.

But isn't it the height of irresponsibility for any Israeli leader to bargain with men such as these? How can our opponents even consider it? How can they put Jewish lives at risk by trusting these men? What are they thinking?

Do Likudniks want Moshe Feiglin or Ehud Barak?

Is there really any difference between Bibi & leftist former PM Ehud Barak (who offered the Temple Mount to Arafat)? They both support the same policies of appeasement of our mortal enemies & running away from the Land of Israel. Some Likudniks think Bibi is their best hope to re-take power. Is it
